

APPOINTMENTS OF JACKSON COUNTY COUNCIL

JACKSON COUNTY LIBRARY BOARD

Established effective 1/1/88

I.C. 20-14 authorizes the establishment of the County Library Board.

The Board consists of seven (7) members, two (2) of whom are appointed by the County Council. Board members may reside in a township except Brownstown, Grassy Fork, or Driftwood (these 3 townships are served by the Brownstown Library Board). County Council appointees are:

The Board of County Commissioners also appoints two (2) members; the Seymour Community School Board appoints two (2) members; and the Presidents of the Carr Township, Brownstown and Crothersville School Boards join to make a single appointment.

BROWNSTOWN LIBRARY BOARD

See I.C. 20-14-2.5-4 and I.C. 20-14-2.5-6. Area served: Brownstown Township, Grassy Fork Township and Driftwood Township. Consists of a seven (7) member board; Brownstown Community School Board appoints three (3) members; County Council appoints two (2); County Commissioners appoint two (2). All are for four (4) year terms. The County Council's appointees are:

JACKSON COUNTY PLAN COMMISSION

I.C. 36-7-4-208 states:

1. Composed on 9 members:
 - (a) 1 County Commissioner;
 - (b) 1 appointee of County Council from its membership;
 - (c) The County Surveyor or a qualified deputy;
 - (d) The County Agricultural agent;
 - (e) 5 citizen members who are:
 - (1) Split politically;
 - (2) Appointed by the Commissioners;
 - (3) May not hold other elective office or appointive office except school board or park board

- (4) Resident of jurisdictional area (resident of unincorporated area after 1/2/84;
- (5) Appointed for 4 years;
- (6) Term expires 1st Monday of January.

County Council appointee: Leon Pottschmidt, appointed Jan 16,2013 (expires 1/1/14)

JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS

I.C. 36-7-4-902 states after 1/2/84:

- 1. Composed of 5 members;
 - (a) 3 citizen members appointed by the executive of the county, one of which must be a member of the Plan Commission and two of which must not be members of the Plan Commission;
 - (b) 1 citizen member appointed by County Council.
- 2. 1 citizen member appointed by the Advisory Plan Commission who must be a member of the Plan Commission other than the one appointed by the Board of Commissioners.
- 3. Members must live within the jurisdictional area of the BZA, i.e. a member cannot live in Seymour (or its “fringe area”) or in Brownstown, Crothersville or Medora.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BOARD

I.C. 7.1-2-4.

A. The “Alcoholic Beverage Board of Jackson County” is composed of three (3) members, each over 21 years old, bona fide residents of the County for the last five (5) years, who have never been convicted of a felony and who do not hold other lucrative public office or employment. The board may not have more than two (2) members of the same political party. The appointive positions are as follows:

- 1. 1 by Board of Commissioners;
- 2. 1 by the Jackson County Council
- 3. 1 by Mayor of Seymour.

DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

Chapter 10, Section 12 of the Jackson County Code (1-10-12) establishes the County Department of Parks and Recreation and a five (5) member board. Two (2) board

members are appointed by the Judge of the Jackson Circuit Court, two (2) members are appointed by the Jackson County Council, with no more than one person for each political party. The County Commissioners shall appoint one (1) member. Members shall be appointed based on their interest and knowledge in parks and recreation. Neither a municipal executive (i.e. mayor) nor a member of the County Council, Board of Commissioners or City or Town Council member may serve as a member of the Park Board.

JACKSON COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

County Council appointment: Charlie Murphy, appointed January 16, 2013. (13 member Board)

AMBULANCE SERVICES AUTHORITY BOARD

(Jackson County Code, Chapter 47) consists of nine (9) members:

- A. One (1) member appointed by the Jackson County Council;
- B. Sheriff (ex-officio);
- C. Seymour Police Chief (ex-officio);
- D. President of Fire Chiefs' Association (ex-officio);
- E. President of County Commissioners (ex-officio);
- F. Four (4) members appointed by County Commissioners (One (1) must represent the Jackson County Hospital, two (2) appointees who are laymen. Of these four (4), two (2) must be Republican and two (2) must be Democrat).

Appointments shall be for four (4) year terms. No appointment member may serve more than two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms.

JACKSON COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

(Authority: Jackson County Code, Chapter 14 and I.C. 13-9.5)

Consists of seven (7) members;

- A. Three (3) County Commissioners
- B. One (1) member appointed by County Council from its membership
- C. The Mayor of Seymour
- D. One (1) member appointed by Seymour City Council from its membership
- E. One (1) member appointed by County Commissioners who is a Town Council Member from either Brownstown, Crothersville or Medora.

County Council appointment: Brian Thompson, appointed January 16, 2013.

JACKSON COUNTY VISITOR PROMOTION COMMISSION

Authority: Jackson County Code 1-10-50 through 1-10-53 (See Ordinance 1996-8 and 1997-18; see also I.C. 6-9-18).

Visitors Commission is composed of 9 members. The County Commissioners appoint 4, Mayor of Seymour appoints 4 (one of who must be a representative of the hotel/motel industry) and the County Council appoints 1 member. After the initial staggering of terms, appointments are for 2 years. No more than 2 of the Commissioners' appointees and no more than 2 of the Mayor's appointees can be affiliated with the same political party. Members may be reappointed.

JACKSON COUNTY REGIONAL SEWAGE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Authority: I.C. 13-26-3-1 and Orders of the Indiana Stream Pollution Control Board dated February 16, 1974 and February 17, 1983.

The sewage district includes all of Jackson County except the incorporated areas of the City of Seymour and the Towns of Brownstown, Crothersville, and Medora. The Board consists of five (5) members, all appointed by the County Council for four (4) year terms. The sewage district is divided into five (5) wards. Trustees shall be registered voters and shall reside in the ward for which he or she serves.
