COUNCIL BILL NO. 13

(2013)

"An ordinance to make an additional appropriation from the named funds of the County of Jackson, Indiana, for the purposes specified."

Whereas, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget;

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF JACKSON, INDIANA:

Section 1: That for the expenses of the County government for the year 2013, the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the specific funds herein named and for the specific purposes herein named and specified, all subject to the laws of the State of Indiana governing the same,
